

How to Create a Fictional Story

1. Open Google Slides or Microsoft PowerPoint.
2. Create a title page for your fictional story.
1. Choose the **standard “I can” statement** that relates to your topic and include it on your story or in the description of your fictional story.
3. For example:
3.RL.1: **I can** ask and answer questions to demonstrate understanding of a text, referring explicitly to the text as the basis for the answers (3rd Grade Standard, Reading Literary Standard).*
4. Make sure you include story elements, such as character, setting, plot, theme and conflict in your **original fictional story**.
5. Optional: As a bonus, you may even create question and answer slides.
6. You may include original pictures, models, photographs and/or clipart.
7. Make sure you double check your work and have your teacher double check your work to ensure it is correct.
8. Save the document.
9. Share!
